- Thus, on October 15-17, 2020 the first series of workshops were organized by the Kist activists in beautiful village of Jokolo, Pankisi Gorge. Together with local Kist trainers,



young activists from Kvemo Kartli and Samtskhe-Javakheti also participated in the events and met their peers living in Pankisi. Up to 30 participants attended the workshops during three days and shared their views and experiences with one another on the following

- topics: Europeanization, disinformation and fake news, EU as a promoter of civic engagement, etc.

- Despite the COVID-19 pandemic, the process went safely and productively. Workshops were held in the courtyard of Nazi's Guesthouse, a local small business and a venue for activists working in the region.

- On the last day, the Youth Summer School participants who organized and conducted this important and interesting event, were awarded with certificates.



- KnowEU will continue the project activities; the next steps envisages organizing similar workshops in Samtskhe-Javakheti and Kvemo Kartli regions.
